Basis Authentication and Anonymous access are enabled and it doesn't make a difference. It's only "Upload Multiple Files" that causes the problem. Single files upload successfully.

- > As I know on SBS 2003, the companyweb will use Windows Authentication
- > method by default, could you test if you use basic authentication method
- > for companyweb, does the issue exist or not? If possible, please also
- > enable anonymous access to companyweb to see if the issue exists or not.

- > As this wired issue, we also can not reproduce it on our side, so we may
- > need long time for troubleshooting.
