- > What is the drive rated for? You do know that 2:1 compression will never
- > ever happen in the real world, right?

Yes, i know... DAT72 is rated 36/72 GB

>> Called HP an they advised me to Switch of the Compression on the SW-Side
>> since the DAT72 does an Hardware Compression.

- > But by telling your job to use hc:/off, you're telling it *not* to use
- > hardware compression. NTBackup by default doesn't use software
- > compression, IIRC.

But the SBS 2003 does it by default.....

Thats why i'm seeking a way to get to those Parameters

- > I suggest you use the HP tape diagnostic tools (HP should be able to help
- > you download/run this).
