2. Does the issue occurs internally or occurs only from internet.
3. Could you test if you navigate to the IIS node on the server management can you browse the default website there? If not, what is the detailed http error?
4. Please also follow the steps below to collect IIS log and send to me, it should be important for us to identify the issue.

1. Open IIS console, right-click 'Default Web Site' and choose 'Properties'. Check 'Enable logging' option. Click 'Properties' button of logging, in 'Advanced' tab, select ALL logging options. Click 'OK' to close the dialog boxes.

NOTE: It's VERY important to enable All the logging options.

2. Repro the issue by accessing RWW site from a internal client computer. Compress and email me the C:\WINDOWS\system32\LogFiles\W3SVC1
