> server is still unable to receive SMTP e-mail. When I run NETSTAT -an, I

> see

> about 40 connections to port 25 in a close\_wait state, but nothing shows

> up

> in Exchange Administrator in the Default SMTP Server. If I try to telnet

> to

> the server on Port 25, I just get timeouts. I have installed the Symanted

> Mail Security for Exchange (included with symantec Enterprise Edition

> 10.0).

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> Has anyone else run into this problem? At one time everything worked

> without problem. Now, it is unable to receive SMTP e-mail.
