

Re: Why use external email hosts?

> 3) Too little bandwidth on the internet connection.

You'll still have the same issue, and in fact it will be worse, if each client is downloading/uploading mail via the same connection from their workstations.

>

> 4) Unreliable internet connectivity.

Same issue as in #3, but a) fix the unreliability as best you can, even if it involves getting another ISP/connection type, b) get someone else to act as backup so their server queues mail and automatically retries delivery every X hours – Mail Hop BackupMX at www.dyndns.org is one option if the ISP won't do it.
