>> and
>> <http://support.microsoft.com/?kbid=905518> – which not applies to
>> "Microsoft Windows Server 2003 for Small Business Server".
>>
>> I tried the workaround resolution of KB 282817 but it did not solved the
>> problem.
>> And I don't think that I need to download the 'Hotfix' as mentioned in KB
>> 905518 because the problem does not occur on already existing XP-clients.
>>
>> I can access the printer directly over the 'TCP/IP port'!
>>
>> For me its a strange but very annoying problem.
>> I am struggling with this problem for over a week now and don't know what
>> to do.

>> Does any of you experts have a idea what is happening to my 'Active
>> Directory' printers?
