1. In your latest reply, you mentioned "The problem is now showing 8 files that cause errors, an increase over the original 4 that showed up". I need to know:

- a. Did you meet any error messages after you disable the offline files?
- b. If yes, please capture screen shots for each of the error messages and send them to the Newsgroup.

2. Please explain in detail "Jadesh indicated that when the users logged in after the Antispam install the Antispam program intercepted the application of the user shell elements and asked if the change from user2 to jadesh shell should be allowed."

Does Jadesh encounter any error messages? If yes, what are they? Where does Jadesh meet these error messages?

3. Please explain in detail "This continued to happen anytime a new user logged on with the corresponding user shell change from their roaming profile". What changes did user make, please?
