I just did a search for \*kb916106\* on all hard drives in my server and the only file that came up was the binary that I extract from PSS. Logging may be another bug that needs to be fixed with this patch.

Let me know if you come up with anything :).

Might be under the ISA one..can you search on your server for KB916106?

That goes ditto for me. Where is the log file?  
Not in my "C:\Windows"  
directory either.

I just installed 916106 as well. Did not "kick" a reboot but I rebooted anyway.

I can't find the log for 916106. Where should it be (it's not in the root of c:\windows with the other KB log files)?

I  
restarted  
IIS  
and  
mail  
began  
flowing,  
but  
OWA  
was  
still  
down  
and  
I  
could  
not  
start  
the  
default  
website  
because  
it  
was

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"in  
use  
by  
another  
process."  
I  
rebooted  
the  
server  
and  
all  
was  
well  
again,  
but  
I  
sat  
with  
mail  
and  
the  
websites  
down  
for  
about  
20  
hours.  
So  
just  
as  
a  
warning  
for  
anyone  
installing  
this  
patch,  
reboot  
the  
server  
afterwards.  
You  
are  
not  
prompted  
to  
do  
so  
by  
the  
installer.
