When I pull up the wins MMC I see SBS server name (libertyrs-main[192.168.16.2]), underneath are "Active Registrations" with no entries in the right hand pane, then "Replication Parteners" again with no entries in the right pane. I have one small question can you recommend some literature or online learning courses that can help me understand SBS better. Can't be to expensive I don't have a lot of money and the company doesn't like to spend money on training. Thanks for all the help that you folks give to use out here.

you don't appear to have WINS enabled on the internal NIC and it is incorrectly bound on the External, no biggie but it indicates misconfiguration. Fix this, then go into the WINS console and delete all records, restart.

When you changed the internal address range, you used the wiz, right?

Connected to the internet via cable modem through a NetGear FVS318 router.
Router address 192.168.0.1. You can read some of the other posts if they will help. the last one was "Problem with getting RWW setup" on 4/6/06. I
