

Re: Set Group Policy to stop user installing any program

Well, a couple of thoughts:

1. All users should have "user" rights only, and not be in the local administrators or power users group (either by individual name or group membership)
2. You can use software restriction policies to allow or deny application usage
3. I don't recommend that you have all users sharing one account, generally speaking. What's the justification for this? How are they expected to use Exchange? How can you control whether someone deletes someone else's files?
4. You can use a mandatory user profile if you wish.

I guess 4 is no longer a couple, but a few. :)
