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Since I don't use these UPSs, not sure I can tell you more. The manual seems to indicate that the "network adapter" password only comes into play if you use the "Configuring a network port UPS" procedure. Since you're using a serial connection, I'd say that's not your problem.

What about removing the software from Add/Remove Programs and then reinstalling it?

I don't use HP servers or UPSs, but does this thing have a password for the "UPS network adapter" as well as the software (same password for both)?

HP Power Management 4.0 software manual

Enter the password that is configured in the UPS network adapter in the

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Password field. The password is case-sensitive. The default adapter password is MustB6.

IMPORTANT: The password you enter must match the password configured in the UPS network adapter. If you want to change the password, first configure the adapter with the new password, and then enter the new password during the Management Server configuration process. For more information about configuring the adapter, refer to the HP Power Products CD that came with the adapter.
