We temporarily disabled 'Ask Unauthenticated Users for Identification' for outbound requests, now we have re-enabled it some users cannot access the internet.

Our setup is:
SBS 2k3
ISA 2000
Win XP SP2 clients

Any advice would be much appreciated.

Firstly, order SBS2003 SP1 media so that you get ISA2004 (I'm assuming you're running Premium).

Secondly, there has to have been other changes made in ISA (or the affected clients) for the behaviour to have changed (toggling just that checkbox would not make any difference).
