Thanks for your update.

You can find the Default Domain policy under the following node:

Open server management console, locate Advanced Management -> Group Policy Management -> Forest -> Domains

And also you can run command "gpmmc" (no quotation marks) to launch the Group Policy Management. You will find the Default Domain policy under the node domain.local.

After you modifying any group policy settings, please run command "gpupdate /force" on the server box and all client computers to take effects the change.

Q: Also – under user properties->Terminal Services Profile , should I check "Deny this user permissions to log on to any terminal server?"

Yes, you can check the option to deny the user remote logon LAN computers.
