I have set up client connection to the server. Everything works fine including the outlook 2003 until i went to remove the microsoft exchange server from the outlook on my laptop (client) and add my account only. The trouble i have is that when i double-click on any emails in the inbox, i was unable to view or read the content of the mails. It says This message has not been fully downloaded from the server. do you want to mark it?.

Is there any way to get this fixed or at least get back to the earlier stage where i had the microsoft exchange server on the list in the outlook?
