I have a client with 100GB+ of data (system, data, sql and exchange). They have a 2 TB NAS running over a gigabit network. I have configured the SBS backup to backup everything each night. It takes roughly 10 hours to complete. I would like to set either a once a week Full backup, and then daily incremental or differential backups. Or, create a full backup once a week, and separate backups for exchange, sharepoint and data. Is there any way to accomplish this with SBS Backup or do I need Symantec BE or another 3rd party backup software? I do know that I can use the regular NT backup and create multiple jobs, however, it won't email reports to me like the SBS backup does.
