Trend CSM v3 and higher now work just fine when installed into the default web site, but it's a good idea to install into a separate web site. Any unused port is fine – in IIS click on web sites; the existing web sites and port numbers are shown – pick a port that's not in use.

Naming the server (as opposed to IP address) is also something I'd recommend. There were some issues with previous versions, but with V3 + using the server name is the preferred method.

During the install, I'd recommend accepting the defaults wherever possible.
