Hey,

I'm trying to configure the Exchange Server of my company (Windows SBS 2003) to do Spam Filtering.

Originally I wanted to create some webpage where my users can fill in IP-addresses from servers they want to block from sending email. I then wanted to insert this IP in the Connection Filtering tab from Exchange (Global Settings => Message Delivery => Properties => Connection Filtering).

Unfortunately I can't find any information on adding IP-addresses here, using ASP or VB code. (If I have to do it manually, it'll take me days and days :o)).

My second idea was to create my own Block List Service. I didn't find any information on Google on how to do this neither ... :o(

So ... My question is:

- Is it possible to install the Exchange Intelligent Message Filtering (included in Exchange SP2) on my Windows SBS 2003? Is it any help for what I want to do?
- What do you guys use to block Spam? Should I invest in a third-party software to do this? Which one? Or can I just use Exchange?
