If you do not do this and EVERYONE reains at READ at the share level it will have an affect of the NTFS permissions on the folder if you were given a group "Modify" access. I believe I said exactly what Justin said that to control access at the folder level with ntfs permissions.

Can you access this share via \\servername\sharename? Do not add groups to the share security tab. All that is needed is you give the group EVERYONE "FULL" access and then control permissions with ntfs at the folder levels.
