There is the thought that 'less ports open, less attack points' you probably want HTTPS for other reasons (OWA/OMA/RPCoverHTTPS) and if RWW is the only method used then the RDP proxy port (4125) is only opened, to the specific requesting IP address, after authentication via SSL.
