I have a medical client that need to find a solution for "Positive ID" that will only allow a workstation to be used while the users key/badge/something is attached to the workstation – the screen should be locked ANYTIME the users ID is not present.

Any ideas?

SmartCards have the ability to require the card to be in the reader to function. They can be configured to lock or logout when the card is removed. Of course keeping the smartcard attached to the person is an "issue".
