| When I attempt to open SharePoint in SQL server management studio on the
| server PC, I get error 26 cannot connect to server\SHAREPOINT.

| I have UDP port 1434 opened on server.

| I can open the default SQL server data base and SBSmonitoring on the
| server

| PC. Only SharePoint is not connecting.

| Since I followed the manual, I removed MSDE program, so now I have no
| SharePoint.

| What do I need to do to make the connection on the server machine so I can
| complete the movement of SharePoint data bases to SQL server 2005?
