◇ 2. Go to Fax snap-in and then click Manage Cover Pages.
◇ 3. Open the cover page you want to modify and then click Open.
◇ 4. Please edit the cover page, move the Sender's address box to the
◇ proper
◇ position.
◇ 5. To save the modified cover page, select *Save As* from the File menu,
◇ name the file, and save the template.
◇ 6. Exit the Fax Cover Page Editor.

◇ Sender's company box.
