I recently installed SP2 for SBS 2003 Premium and for Exchange. Soon after, as the IP address leases began to expire, clients could no longer renew their IP address. Of course, I cannot really attribute SP2 for this problem, but these symptoms happened days after. I verified cabling, tried assigning static IPs, etc, but no use. Restarted the server, DHCP, DNS, ran the ICW, but only the server can connect to the Internet.. The only error I see in Event Viewer is
