After installing SP1 for SBS 2003 I have an issue with IIS not seemingly accepting Windows Integrated Authentications.

I used the 5 downloads to service pack the server and did have an issue with the companyweb, which microsoft sorted by installing sharepoint service pack 2. Within companyweb I call an IIS web page which changes dependant on the user logged on the computer, currently this prompts for credentials before displaying the page correctly

I think its IIS not companyweb as if I open the same IIS webpage through IE negating the companyweb I still experience the same issue.

I do have windows integrated authentication and basic settings chosen on the directory security tab of the webpages properties within IIS. If I change to anonymous the page goes straight in but obviously doesnt work correctly as I need to know the user looking at the page.
