Goto IIS Manager, "Default Web Site" / "Properties" and under "ASP.NET", make sure that the version listed is 1.1 . Do the same for the "Remote" virtual directory and then from the command prompt run: iisreset /noforce

I don't know if that will help but it's possible that the program you installed changed the version of ASP.NET and created the problem you have

I have SBS2003 (premium edition) and just recently noticed that our OWA/RWW is not accessible...what has changed: over the weekend I install CA Integrated Threat Management R8 (to combine our antivirus and pestpatrol software) but I couldn't tell you at which point the OWA/RWW services stopped working.

Since I've tried restarting the services: IIS, ISA, Web Proxy, WWW, Routing and Remote but nothing seemed to work, then I re-ran the CEICW but still nothing, any ideas?
