OK i checked that KB article and it basically tells me that for some reason my permissions are off. I checked the admin permissions on the box and they seemed fine. But check this out I ran the MS server 03 patch for post SBS SP2 and not only did that clear up our VPN/RDP issues but It also fixed our exchange manager issue. I had know idea that those two were even tied together?

I installed the post patch and RDP worked smoothly after that. I was not able to update exchange manager, what I was refering to was updating to exchange sp2. after the update I am still not able to get my manager to work. It will throw me this error:

Invalid Handle Facility: Win32 ID No: 80070006 Exchange System Manager

I checked around to no avail, its like this error does not exist or i am just very special lol

Connecting via RDP is a known possible side effect with ISA, there's a post SP2 patch on the MU to disable Checksum and RSS.

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As far as updating system manager...by what means did you update this?

Not sure what you mean by this?

Cris Hanna [SBS-MVP] wrote:

Well we've been strongly encouraging folks not to install SP2 on SBS for sometime Even uninstalling may not clear the issue

Since this appears to be related to the installation of SP2 I would call CSS right away as this should be a free call

I would also search the KB for SBS and SP2 and you can try those suggestions first and see if it resolves
