with binary and PASV option.  
Big files (>3.7 Mo ~2min transfert time) doesn't receive a succes response  
from the other server even so the file arrives completely, after the timeout  
I'm diconnected. With smaler files no problem.  
The same ftp transfert with XP or Win2000 no problem.
