scenario:

SBS with 2 x NIC's

Internal NIC:
IP: 192.168.0.1
Sub: 255.255.255.0

WAN NIC:
IP: 192.168.2.9
Sub: 255.255.255.0
GW: 192.168.2.10

ISP created VPN between two branch offices. Branch office can ping 192.168.2.9 and 2.10.
