I'm wondering if there are any tweaks i can do to our network to speed up our internet connection...i know that my brother has ISA 2004, like we do, and a consultant informed him that if he disabled it and went with a Firebox that it would be safer (i know that isn't true), but faster as well...so, he did disable it and it sped things up quite a bit -- he says sites load very very fast now and the whole network experience is faster...his was a brand new install (that i did myself) so i know that his settings weren't tweaked to be slower - but i'm wondering if there are some settings i can tweak to speed things up?

We have a 10 meg Fiber Optic line and i've yet to see close to those speeds (but, if i plug a laptop right into the line, bypassing the server i get almost 10 meg everytime)...
