You want 4 users to have access to that account on the ISP's web mail?

or:

There is an account that is/was hosted by the ISP:

info@xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx or info@xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx
