Does anyone know a utility that will run in windows and allow me to see the status of the two drives?

Hi,

There is an Intel Storage manager program that you can download from the mobo manufacturer or from Intel directly. In my case this isn't a web manager, but allows you to see the state of the drives from an app via Terminal Services and the like, but this is a very cheap server mobo.
