Question: will Backup Exec 9.1 ('normal' windows version) work on SBS2003 R2?

We have a new client who is finally stepping up to the server-platform hardware (running four servers on workstation-class machines running Windows Server 2003) and are going to purchase a Dell PE1900 for them running SBS2003 R2.

They have Backup Exec 9.1 (I know....I know). I am suggesting that they go to the current version (Backup Exec 12D) or that they use the SBS Backup.
