I prefer if we keep it here in the group since I don't have that much free time. Sometimes I need to clear my head and I just jump in here. Sorry about that...

You wrote that there is no SQL instance under Services. Isn't there a MSSQL\$SBSMONITORING service running? That's the instance for the Monitoring database. If there isn't, you have to go to the Control Panel, Windows Small Business Server 2003 and reinstall the Monitoring component. Just follow the wizard, then put the 'Server Tools' in Maintenance Mode and the 'Monitoring' in Reinstall.

After you complete this, see if Monitoring is working. The Best Practices Analyzer shows the steps you need to take. Fix them one at a time. The Companyweb issue leave it for the end. As far as the public site goes, it isn't recommended to have a public facing site on the SBS server.
