Not that we, or at least I, am not willing to help, but these things can be lots of blind alleys and questions like: "What symptoms" or "When" or "what is the rest of the message".

I suggest you run the errors through www.eventid.net first to see if you can focus in on the actual problem, and also try some of the verbiage from the error in google groups advanced search.

However, others may have had this happen to them and have their notes at hand and post the exact cause and fix in the next ten minutes.

Still, the sources I listed are excellent, and even if you don't join [eventid.net](http://www.eventid.net), you still can use this great resource.

ID: 10016

Description:

I am afraid i am not sure which application it's referring to.

W32Time with ID: 4

Description: Application experience lookup service failed to start

W32Time with ID: 21

none of the input providers are available. The time service has no source of accurate time.
