> IUSR\_%COMPUTERNAME% in the root directory using the xcacls.vbs tool:

>

> cscript xcacls.vbs d:\inetpub\wwwroot /E /D IUSR\_%COMPUTERNAME%:W

>

> The following rights are denied:

> SYNCHRONIZE

> FILE\_WRITE\_DATA

> FILE\_APPEND\_DATA

> FILE\_WRITE\_EA

> FILE\_WRITE\_ATTRIBUTES

>

> Then IIS stop serving pages, it requires authentication.

>

> If I apply the same setting using the GUI, only the last four rights are

> denied, and the system works properly.
