Hello,

I use an external program called DUMPACL (www.somarsoft.com) for this purpose.

DUMPACL can be invoked from a command line to generate a CSV file of user rights. The syntax looks something like the following:

```
dumpacl /rpt=rights /saveas=csv /outfile=rights.csv /computer=hostname
```

You can run dumpacl from either a RUN or EXEC shell in VBScript and then parse the resulting CSV file. The "Log On Locally" privilege will show up as "SeInteractiveLogonRight".

Cool! I wasn't aware that DumpSec (formerly known as DumpAcl) could obtain the user rights assignments :-)
