> *Here is a solution I found that works with Windows Server 2003*

>

> *1) Go to*

> <http://h18023.www1.hp.com/support/files/server/us/download/20313.html>

> *and download the softpaq*

> *2) Extract the drivers to a folder of your choice.*

> *3) Copy ONLY the "CpqCissm.sys" file from the folder that you extracted the*

> *drivers to.*

> *4) Paste the above file to c:\%windir%\system32\drivers on your Master*

> *Device*

> *5) Capture the image*

>

> *\*\* Since you already have an image created, you might just try mounting your*

> *image and adding the driver in that way before you redeploy it.*

>

> *You should now be able to have a more portable image. The driver you copied*

> *encompasses the following controllers:*

> *Smart Array 5300 Controller*

> *Smart Array 5i*

> *Smart Array 532 Controller*

> *Smart Array 5312 Controller*

> *If not, you might want to look at rebuilding your image and using F6 to add*  
> *in the storage controller drivers this way. Now they will be a part of the*  
> *image you are capturing.*
