>I slipstreamed sp1 into my volume license server 2003 std CD and
>attempted a clean install on two new Dell Poweredge 750's. I've tried
>installing with and without using the Dell utility CD and either way
>get this error at the beginning of setup, a few seconds after seeing
>"Press F6 to load an additional SCSI or RAID driver"..
>
>The file amdide.sys could not be found
>Press any key to continue
>
>...at which point setup fails and exits.
>
>This file, amdide.sys is new to sp1 and does not exist on my original
>CD. I extracted the file from the service pack and expanded it reveal
>the version information:
>
>File Version: 5.2.3790.1830
>Description: AMD IDE Driver
>Copyright: Copyright (C) AMD 2003
>
>
>The Dell utility CD actually pre-copies all the basic setup files to a
>temp folder on the C drive and since I chose FAT32 I was able to
>reboot on a DOS floppy disk and look for the file. It is there in
>compressed format as amdide.sy_. Just for grins I copied the
>uncompressed file – amdide.sys into the folder and rebooted but it
>didn't help.
>
>It isn't my CD, it loads fine on another Dell workstation I use as a
>test server. It's something to do with this model of server and the
>new AMD ide driver. Can anyone assist?
