I have a small AD network. I am not very familiar with AD so I apologize if I state things poorly.

We had three servers (Server 2003 SE) running AD and DSN which I will refer to as server1, server2, server3. Server1 and server2 were on-line from day one. Server3 was added much later. Server3 has now gone into total melt down on us and we are running on the original server2.

I have discovered that when I do simple things like add a share on a workstation I only get the hostname as a location to add users from. My domain is no longer there.

I can't open existing shares from the workstations in the domains. I can open them from the servers.

I ran "NETDOM query fsmo" and got the following result.

Schema owner server2.vcg.umn.edu

Domain role owner server2.vcg.umn.edu

PDC role server1.vcg.umn.edu

RID pool manager server2.vcg.umn.edu

Infrastructure owner server1.vcg.umn.edu
