- > To limit the size of this folder via GPO, open the Group Policy
  - > editor and expand User Configuration > Windows Settings. Right
  - > click Internet Explorer Maintenance and select Preference Mode.
  - > Click the Advanced container. Right click Corporate Settings and
  - > select Properties. You should have 4 options displayed,
  - > TIF(User), TIF(Machine), Code Download, and Related Sites and
  - > Errors. Set the size you wish under the TIF(User) and/or
  - > TIF(Machine).
  - >
  - > I have only tested this policy in a 2003 domain, not a 2000
  - > domain. However, I think it is still there in a 2000 domain...
  - >
