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Don't do this for every user!

When you want to install an application on a TS for multiple users, you do so as the Administrator. By putting the server into "install mode", you actually "tell" the server that it must monitor all changes to the registry and file system that are made by the installation, and to give each user a private copy of these registry and ini-file changes, as soon as they logon to the TS.
