I can log on to the console as administrator as shown in the above output.

Using mstsc.exe from a command prompt on the server gives me the same result as trying it from a client, i.e. it almost immediately returns me to a connect button.

There is nothing in any of the event logs. I checked in application, security and system logs. nothing.
