I'm still not 100% sure about some details, but when you log on to the servers in domain A, you'll either have to use a user account which exists in domain A, or you'll have to create a trust relationship between the 2 domains, so that domain A trusts domain B.

Have you tried specifying the username as "domain\username" in stead of just "username"?

Server 1. DC (domainA)+ terminal server licensing + IIS (with rdp client 5.2.379.0)

Server 2. TS + internal application

I need to connect to the domain from another domainB with IIS, directly rdp client function correctly.
