Clients connecting from the Internet or through a VPN sometimes do not get their local drives mapped. What usually happens is that an icon will show up that says it's a "system folder", but they will get an access denied/resource not available error if they try to click on it.

Again, this only happens about 30% of the time, and not to all clients.

I've even had it happen to me once internally (out of 20 connection attempts) – however it's definitely more predominant from outside the network.
