- . Go to the Start Menu and the Run box.
- . Type in the following:
 - control userpasswords2
- . now click OK
- . In the new Windows that appears select the account you wish to make the primary logon.
- . Now uncheck the "Users must enter a username and password..." box.
- . Hit Apply and a dialog box will appear asking you to confirm the selected users password.

Click OK.

The changes will work the next time you restart your computer.
