- > *(motherboard, proc, HDD, RAM) and reinstalled Win2K Pro, but the error*
- > *re-occurs at the same point (after installing IE 6 SP1). I even tried to*
- > *download the update from the MS Downloads site but got the same results.*

- > *Could there be something wrong with the update?*

Install this one, it includes a lot of updates to KB832894/MS04-004, and it also includes the latest cumulative security update for Internet Explorer (KB867801/MS04-025):
