Similar problem w/ Win2k sp4 on a workstation here. Using Netscape 7.1 for email, it wasn't possible to reply to messages because of an SMTP error. For some reason composing a new message worked though. Uninstalling KB893066 cleared the problem. I don't know how to remove the Hotfix from a server. On some other workstations the KB893066 causes the computer to hang on "applying computer settings..." during startup. No solution yet, just letting you know that other people are having a problem with this update.

- > I see on XP Pro, the patch can be removed from the Add/Remove, but on 2003
- > Server it is not listed.

- > I checked the previous articles about the netowrk slow down, and tried the
- > registry key that was suggested, however, again the detail on what value it
- > needs to be is too vague.
- >
- > I ended up having to run Windows Setup/Repair to get me back to work, but I
- > was wondering if anyone else was experiencing this problem.
