I think I may have a problem with the slipstreaming. I don't have the "network version for IT professionals" of SP2 (at least I don't think I do?). I have a CD that I requested and received from Microsoft. It is called "Windows XP Service Pack 2" and is SKU #E85-03147. Does this mean anything to you? Thanks again for all of your advice.

Also, How do I save the other updates to CD? I used the update manager to download and install all of the other critical updates except for SP2. Is there a way to back them up onto a CD? I'll look forward to your reply. Thanks again!

Suggest you skip slipstreaming the updates and use this method to slipstream SP2 with XP :
