After several weeks of attempts, I'm still having a problem installing Security Update for Office XP (KB873352). I am logged in as administrator. Initializing occurs, but installing does not. Can anyone advise me on how to correct this? Thanks...

My registry keys were fine, but the update failed because PA56401.cab was missing from MSOcache. Putting the installer CD in the CD drive solved the problem. Why couldn't the update asked for it instead of just failing? The recent problems with WGA and Office update are the best advertisement for Linux.
