One care always tells me my computer needs help because Microsoft .Net framework 1.1 service pack needed as a critical update. Won't install over and over. two error codes trying all sorts of things error 0x643 and error 1706 no valid source could be found. below is what i asked microsoft to help me with but so far i don't even know if they got my two emails:

questions:

1)Do I need framework 1.1 service pack like microsoft update says I need?

2)Is Live OneCare a replacement for my old antivirus and firewall or do i need to products?

3)Should I use dotnetfx_cleanup_tool? I have read some warnings and concerns about dotnetfx_cleanup_tool.

4)Should I use my original DELL disk and re install Windows XP?

5)Should I re install Windows XP service pack 2? I got it on cd.

6)Does every computer have this framework problem? I have a Compaq computer I need to update on line and I want to put LIve OneCare on it but I'm afraid if it does what my Dell is doing with Live OneCar.

Please give some instructions and direction

I have used the repair command under add/delete programs to repair Microsoft framework 2.0 but still that framework 1.1 service pack won't install. The "work around" microsoft gives is crazy---how is turning off my anti virus program (which is one_care) going to solve the problem? I've always had auto updates on so why does one_care want me to update now when this update has been around for a long time. Did microsoft auto update not consider this a critical update??
